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Automate Gift Recs from Milestones

Identify gift decision points and automate data-driven prompts while preserving human oversight. This page outlines what to automate, review, and data requirements.

Key move Start with a 4-week pilot on one customer segment and measure feasibility.

PRACTICAL CHECKLIST

- 01** Define data sources: client milestones, product usage, renewals, support interactions, and feedback.
- 02** Model data lineage and a schema for a centralized gifts dataset.
- 03** Create standardized prompts that map milestones to gift ideas and budget ranges.
- 04** Automate gift generation with AI prompts, routing to human review for final approval.
- 05** Set weekly or monthly cadences for gift suggestions and approvals.
- 06** Capture metrics: hit rate, time-to-approve, and lift in client engagement.
- 07** Data privacy: restrict sensitive data; enforce access controls.

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Rollout Plan & Weekly Tasks

Key move Limit data access to need-to-know roles; document approval thresholds.

PRACTICAL CHECKLIST

01 Week 1: Confirm data sources and assign data owners, run initial quality checks.

02 Week 2: Build the gifts dataset, prompts, and initial automation rules.

03 Week 3: Implement human-review gateway and approval thresholds.

04 Week 4: Pilot with a small cohort; collect feedback.

05 Week 5: Refine prompts, budgets, and escalation paths.

06 Week 6: Move to broader rollout or conclude pilot with learnings.

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Risks, Guardrails & Ownership

Identify risks, governance structures, and success metrics. Define clear ownership for data, prompts, and response workflows.

Key move Document a simple rollback path if a prompt behaves unexpectedly.

PRACTICAL CHECKLIST

- 01** Risk: protect privacy; minimize data exposure with masking and access controls.
- 02** Guardrail: require human review for high-value or high-cost gifts.
- 03** Guardrail: budget caps per client tier and quarterly spend reviews.
- 04** Approval: establish decision owners for prompts, data usage, and compliance.
- 05** Measurement: track hit rate, time-to-approval, client satisfaction, and gift ROI.
- 06** Ownership: CS lead owns process; data engineer owns data pipeline; legal oversees privacy.
- 07** Audits: schedule biannual audits of prompts and outcomes.
