- 03** Ensure data quality: timestamps, units, deduplication, alignment, and completeness checks.
- 04** Automate calculations for standard KPIs where safe to reduce manual steps.
- 05** Keep human review for exceptions, interpretation, and action decisions.
- 06** Establish data access controls and governance to safeguard integrity.
- 07** Start with 1–2 KPIs and stand up a simple weekly review.

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From KPI Movements to Trends

Map KPI changes to trends. Use AI to surface plausible root causes and correlations.

Key move Always validate AI-suggested causes with domain context.

PRACTICAL CHECKLIST

- 01** Classify movements: stable, rising, falling, or volatile.
- 02** Decompose series with simple trend/cycle/signal methods.
- 03** Use AI to generate plausible root-cause hypotheses with feature context.
- 04** Require guardrails: minimum correlation and human sanity checks.
- 05** Create short, testable causal hypotheses and validation steps.
- 06** Link root causes to concrete actions and owners.
- 07** Document assumptions and decisions for auditability.

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Actionable Recommendations & Adoption

Turn insights into safe, auditable actions. Define ownership, guardrails, and weekly cadence.

Key move Capture rationale and outcomes in the KPI commentary log.

PRACTICAL CHECKLIST

- 01** Create action templates: if KPI deviation then trigger staffing, maintenance, or process change.
- 02** Define roles: data collector, analyst, reviewer, and decision owner.
- 03** Automate anomaly flags and commentary generation where appropriate.
- 04** Require human review for high-risk or high-cost actions.
- 05** Implement approval gates and clear accountability lines.
- 06** Measure impact: track action outcomes and KPI delta post-implementation.
- 07** Run weekly reviews to close feedback loops and refine hypotheses.
