Prepare negotiation positions from spend history, alternatives, and risk-aware guardrails to secure value.

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What to automate and what to review

Prepare AI-supported negotiation briefs by automating data collection while keeping critical decisions human-reviewed.

Key move Always verify AI briefs with legal and category owners before negotiation.

PRACTICAL CHECKLIST

- 01** Aggregate spend history by supplier, category, contract duration, and renewal dates.
- 02** Identify top negotiation levers: price, volume, payment terms, SLAs, and penalties.
- 03** Create AI-generated negotiation briefs summarizing spend, options, risks, and recommended positions.
- 04** Evaluate alternatives: competitive bids, off-contract options, and supplier substitutions.
- 05** Set target outcomes: cost savings, risk reduction, and service improvements.
- 06** Define approvals: legal, compliance, and executive sponsorship thresholds.
- 07** Establish an AI-in-the-loop review workflow with clear ownership.

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Inputs and Tools for AI Prep

Build a reliable data foundation and select tooling to turn data into actionable negotiation guidance.

Key move **Ownership: procurement lead owns the final negotiation brief and approvals.**

PRACTICAL CHECKLIST

- 01** Aggregate spend history from ERP and contracts by supplier, category, and term length.
- 02** Ensure data quality: deduplicate vendors, normalize fields, and map terms consistently.
- 03** Identify key data sources: contracts, performance metrics, spend dashboards, supplier risk scores.
- 04** Leverage tools: spend analytics, AI briefs, contract repository, and workflow automation.
- 05** In AI briefs, link issues to terms, SLAs, and renewal risk.
- 06** Include human review points for pricing exceptions and non-standard terms.
- 07** Define guardrails: privacy, approvals, and policy-compliant use of AI in negotiations.

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4-Week AI Negotiation Pilot

A weekly, low-risk rollout to test AI-supported negotiation prep and establish governance.

Key move Legal review for any price or term changes before finalizing.

PRACTICAL CHECKLIST

- 01** Week 1: assemble data, clean spend data, map suppliers, and assign data owners.
- 02** Week 2: configure AI briefs with spend metrics and target outcomes; circulate for sign-off.
- 03** Week 3: run a controlled negotiation with one supplier using AI briefs.
- 04** Week 4: measure outcomes, capture feedback, update guardrails, and plan scale.
- 05** Measure outcomes: savings, cycle time, contract compliance, governance adherence.
- 06** Ownership: procurement lead, legal reviewer, and data steward roles.
- 07** Risks: data leakage, model errors, misinterpretation; mitigate with approvals and human-in-the-loop.
