Automate Release Notes from Commits

AI can transform commit messages into draft release notes. This page outlines automation scope, human reviews, and required tools.

Key move Start with a single project; pilot with 2 weeks of commits and measure note quality.

PRACTICAL CHECKLIST

- 01** Ingest commit messages from your VCS (GitHub/GitLab) and extract change intent (bugfix, feature, improvement).
- 02** Classify changes into release note sections: What changed, Why it matters, How to test, and Impact.
- 03** Summarize each change into concise, reader-friendly sentences suitable for a public release.
- 04** Format notes to a consistent template (version, date, owners, links).
- 05** Flag low-confidence or ambiguous commits for manual review before publishing.
- 06** Store provenance metadata (commit SHAs, author, timestamp) for traceability.

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Weekly AI Release Notes Pilot

Plan a 4-week pilot to validate impact and refine the notes template. This page provides weekly steps, ownership, and lightweight approvals.

Key move Keep notes on why a draft was revised to support audits and future improvements.

PRACTICAL CHECKLIST

- 01** Week 1: Define scope, data sources (Git, PRs), success metrics, and release notes template; assign ownership.
- 02** Week 2: Connect commit data feed to AI generator; run tests and review a small batch.
- 03** Week 3: Apply formatting, enforce template, and publish drafts to a staging doc.
- 04** Week 4: Measure outcomes, collect feedback, adjust templates, and plan rollout to other teams.
- 05** Ownership: designate PM as owner, AI as facilitator, reviewers as gatekeepers.
- 06** Approvals: lightweight, cross-notes sign-off, no heavy change control.

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Risks, Guardrails, Metrics

Automation can misinterpret commits; define guardrails and measurement to maintain quality. This page covers risk management and ownership.

Key move Document approval rationale for each note to support audits and future improvements.

PRACTICAL CHECKLIST

- 01** Risk: AI misinterprets commits; implement confidence scoring and mandatory human review for uncertain items.
- 02** Guardrail: enforce a release notes template and style guide to ensure consistency.
- 03** Approval: define who signs off draft notes before publication (PM lead or PMO).
- 04** Data security: avoid embedding secrets; redact credentials and sensitive data in drafts.
- 05** Quality metrics: measure accuracy, edit time saved, and reader satisfaction after publish.
- 06** Version control: track changes to notes with commit SHAs and reviewer comments.
- 07** Escalation: define when to rollback notes or revert publication.
