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AI Portfolio Scorecard Overview

A lightweight framework to assess leadership AI initiatives. It aligns strategy, execution, and measurable outcomes.

Key move Start with 2 pilot initiatives to calibrate scoring and assumptions

PRACTICAL CHECKLIST

- 01** Strategic value: rate impact on revenue, cost, and competitive advantage.
- 02** Adoption readiness: assess executive sponsorship, user readiness, and change potential.
- 03** Delivery status: track stage (concept, pilot, scale, or sunset).
- 04** Risk and compliance: flag data privacy, security, ethics, and regulatory concerns.
- 05** Cost and reuse: estimate TCO and record reusable assets.
- 06** Measurable outcomes: define KPIs, milestones, and evidence of value.
- 07** Ownership: assign a lead and establish a bi-weekly governance cadence.

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What to Automate and What to Review

Identify decision-heavy, repeatable tasks suitable for automation. Preserve human review for judgment, ethics, and strategy.

Key move Start with a two-week sprint to validate automation reach.

PRACTICAL CHECKLIST

- 01** Automate: executive summaries from meetings and dashboards; save time for leadership.
- 02** Keep human-reviewed: strategic decisions, policy changes, and high-risk outcomes.
- 03** Data/tools needed: access to source systems, data quality, and auditable logs.
- 04** Examples for leadership: AI-assisted agenda drafting, KPI dashboard updates, and scenario-informed planning.
- 05** Data governance: define data ownership, lineage, retention, and privacy controls.
- 06** Adoption steps: pilot with 1-2 leaders, measure speed and accuracy improvements.

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Adoption Plan, Risks, and Accountability

Establish a clear ownership model and governance cadence. Track delivery status, risk, and cost with transparent reporting.

Key move Appoint a single AI Portfolio Owner responsible for cadence.

PRACTICAL CHECKLIST

- 01** Weekly updates: review progress, blockers, and updated value estimates.
- 02** Owner and sponsor: assign an AI Portfolio Owner and an executive sponsor.
- 03** Approvals: define stage gates for pilot go/no-go and scale.
- 04** Guardrails: data privacy, security, bias, and ethics controls.
- 05** Measurement: track KPIs, adoption velocity, and realized value.
- 06** Asset reuse: catalog templates, dashboards, and AI models for future use.
